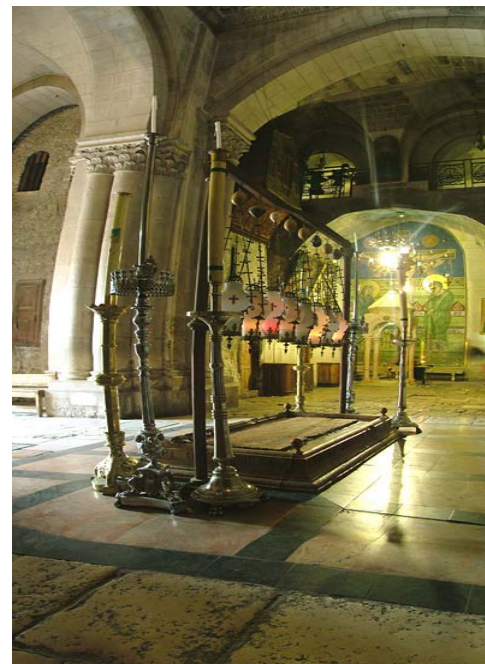


HOLY LAND IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF JESUS WITH A VISIT INTO EGYPT

TIBERIAS / MT. TABOR / JERUSALEM / CANA / GALILEE / BETHLEHEM / NAZARETH / CAIRO

Travel date:
June 1 - 14, 2010

Let us rejoice in the Resurrection as we walk in the footsteps of Jesus throughout the Holy Land. This pilgrimage takes us to the major pilgrimage sites in the Holy Land where we will celebrate the great mysteries of His life: the nativity in Bethlehem; his simple life in Nazareth; the miracles of the loaves and fishes at Tabgha and the changing of water to wine at Cana; the Transfiguration at Mt. Tabor; the Last Supper; the Agony in the garden of Gethsemane; and, finally, his passion and death on the Via Dolorosa and at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

June 1, 2010: Our pilgrimage begins as we depart Kansas City International Airport for an overnight flight to the Holy Land.

June 2: This afternoon, we'll find ourselves in the land of Jesus. Upon Arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, we'll transfer to Netanya and the Mediterranean shore. Overnight Netanya.

June 3: Today we'll drive to Caesarea, once the Roman capital of the Holy Land. We'll see the excavations of the Roman statues, the aqueduct, and the amphitheater. On to Meggido, King Solomon's Stables, and the twenty layers of civilization. Next, we'll ascend Mt. Carmel. Our last visit is at Acre, the Crusaders stronghold. Overnight Tiberias.

June 4: Today our Chaplain will take the rudder for our boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We'll visit Capernaum and the house of St. Peter. Then, on to Tabgha where Our Lord multiplied the loaves and the fishes to feed the multitudes. In our motor coach, we'll ascend the Mount of Beatitudes, where Our Lord gave the Sermon on the Mount. Overnight Tiberias.

June 5: Today, we will drive to Nain, where Jesus raised the widow's son. Then, we ascend to the magnificent gardens atop Mt. Tabor, site of the Transfiguration. This place also commands a spectacular view of the Upper Galilee. Overnight Tiberias.

June 6: Today, we'll visit Cana and Nazareth. We will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation and then visit St. Joseph's Carpentry Shop. On our way to Jerusalem, we'll visit Jericho, the oldest city in the world and the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem. Overnight Jerusalem.

June 7: Today begins with an ascent of the Mount of Olives and a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Next, we move on to the garden of Gethsemane and a visit to the Basilica of the Agony. Tour the Old City, the western Wall, the Temple Mount, and the Dome of the Rock. Next, we'll walk the Via Dolorosa and pray at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Our touring will end with a visit to the tomb of King David, the room of the Last Supper, and the Dormition Abbey. Overnight Jerusalem.

June 8: Today visit the Good Samaritan Inn at 1200 ft below sea level. Next, ascend by cable car to the spectacular Zealot fortress of Masada. From here we'll head to Qumran, where the famous Dead Sea Scrolls were found, and ascend the Mt. of Temptation. Overnight Jerusalem.

June 9: Day at leisure. Overnight Jerusalem.

June 10: Today with fond memories of our travels throughout the Holy Land, we'll head to the airport for our flight home.

Pilgrimage Extension to Cairo:

June 10: Depart Jerusalem. Traveling ancient caravan routes we make our way to Taba, and arrive in time for dinner. Overnight Taba.

June 11: Today we will visit the Monastery of St. Catherine at the base of Mount Sinai. Trace the route of the Exodus along the eastern Sinai coast to Wadi Feiran where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Travel to Elim where the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Our final visit will be Marah by the Red Sea where the "waters were bitter". Continue to Cairo. Overnight Cairo.

June 12: Today we'll visit Joseph's River and Lake, created during the period of the seven years of famine. Visit a grain silo of the kind established under Joseph's rule to store grain. Travel as Abraham did to Memphis (Biblical Noph) and on to Sakkara where you will see the Step Pyramid, world's oldest stone structure. Overnight Cairo.

June 13: Visit the ancient treasures of the Egyptian Museum. See the Great Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. Follow the way of the Holy Family into Egypt as you explore the Coptic Hanging Church, Coptic Museum and Ben Ezra Synagogue. Overnight Cairo.

June 14: Departure for the airport and return flight to Kansas City.
